

How to tackle in the Consumer-Oriented Project Work

Students within the Master's Program in Consumer Affairs have the possibility to participate in a project work in accordance with § 37a General Academic Regulations/FPSO. Depending on the workload, 6 or 12 Credits are awarded.

To find a **project** you can consult at the websites of the chairs that are of interest to you. You can also address your request directly to one of the members of this chair. There is also a collection of projects at <http://social.tum-bwl.com/>

The project has to meet the following conditions:

- The project has to be done in cooperation with at least one other student who does not necessarily have to be enrolled in the Consumer Affairs program.
- The topic has to be connected to the contents of the Consumer Affairs program.
- It has to be a practical or research project.
- The project has to be **supervised by** an official internal examiner of the Technische Universität München. Even if you participate in a project in cooperation with a company, make sure that you are nevertheless supervised by an official examiner of the Technische Universität München.
- The project has to be **documented** in a **final report**.

As soon as you have found a project work and a supervisor, please **register** it with the TUM School of Management using the form you will find in the "Download" section of the MCA website before the start of the project. Please hand in the completed form to your MCA program coordinator of the TUM School of Management.

While completing the project work, make sure that you are enrolled and do not apply for a leave of absence. As a rule, you are not allowed to sign up for examinations – including projects, papers, - during a leave of absence.
